

ABOUT CCA

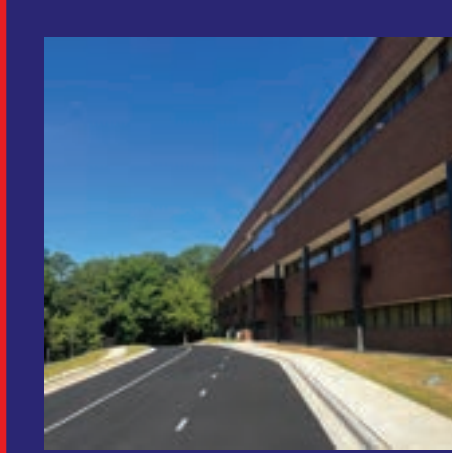

THE CAMPUS

The Central Carolina Academy campus is located at 1801 Douglas Drive in Sanford, NC. The extensive, two-year renovation is taking the facility from a corporate building to a school. When complete, three stories of classroom, office, and meeting/eating space will house middle and high school students. The first graduates will be the Class of 2025.



RENOVATION

Central Carolina Academy held a ribbon-cutting ceremony on Sunday afternoon, September 18, 2022. The event celebrated the opening of Lee County's newest public charter school and the conclusion of phase one of the campus renovation project. Currently, classrooms occupy the third floor of the building. The full project is scheduled for completion before the 2023-2024 school year begins. The school enrollment will grow in the next few years to over 660 students in grades 6-12.

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ACADEMICS

CAREER & COLLEGE PROMISE

The pinnacle of the academic program at Central Carolina Academy is the NC Career and College Promise (CCP). Eleventh and twelfth grade students will focus on tuition-free, college level courses offered through the CCP. A partnership with Central Carolina Community College in Sanford allows upperclassmen to take college transfer courses and/or Career and Technical Education courses across a wide variety of career fields.



ELECTIVE HIGHLIGHT: SOAR

In addition to other elective courses, all students take a SOAR elective during the school year that helps them build skills in the “unwritten curriculum” that are crucial to success. Skills include time management, organization, responsibility, self-advocacy, teamwork, and public speaking.
